## LESSON REVIEW ANSWERS

1. What does Jeremiah 29:11 tell you about God?

God has good plans for me, doesn't harm me, gives me a hope, and gives me a future.

2. Who steals from you, and who gives abundantly to you (John 10:10 and Eph. 3:20)?

The devil steals from me, and God gives abundantly to me.

3. What impact does the simple revelation "God is good; devil is bad" have on your health and your life right now?

Possible answers: When I see evil, I will not assume it is God punishing me; I know God is good, so I will proclaim that the bad I see is from the Enemy, and I have authority over it; Now I can know immediately when the Enemy is lying to me, and I can speak the truth.

4. What is the danger in viewing God in the same way you view your earthly father?

Possible answers: I might be disappointed with my earthly father; I might not recognize that I don't have to be afraid to come to Him; the danger comes from limiting God.

5. When the Enemy attacks believers with sickness (John 10:10), what does he probably hope will happen?

Possible answer: The Enemy does not want Christians to understand Who lives within them—God the Healer—and that they are filled with healing instead of filled with sickness.

6. What lies from the Enemy can you combat with the true nature of God revealed in His names?

Possible answer: If I'm feeling unsettled about a possible negative report from the doctor, *Jehovah-Shalom* and *Jehovah-Rapha* remind me that I am filled with peace and healing because those are part of the true nature of God.

7. What will understanding more about the true nature of God do for you?

Possible answer: Understanding the true nature of God will help me see that He wants to fellowship with me, bless me, prosper me, heal me, etc.
